



Vocabulary

BIRD - An animal whose body is covered with feathers and has wings with which most can fly

FEATHER - A light growth covering on a bird that protects it from the weather and allows it to fly

EGG - A round or oval hard shell that protects a chick (or reptile) while it grows until it is ready to hatch

TALON - A claw on a bird of prey

BEAK - A bird's bill

HUNT - To look for food to catch and eat

PREY - An animal caught by another animal to eat

PREDATOR - The animal that catches other animals to eat

FOREST - A large area of land covered with trees

BIRD OF PREY - A bird that eats or preys on other animals
